### **Step-By-Step Instructions**

#### Warning:

- This product is for towing purposes only and must only be loaded as shown in your vehicle Owner's Manual.
- This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded, or modified in any way.
- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present
- All load ratings shown are under the assumption your trailer has a functional braking system installed
- When installed in positions other than the one depicted in these instructions the Tow Ball Mount may interfere or obstruct certain features of your vehicle (tailgate opening, Chassis clearance, etc.)

#### General:


- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar. (Tray, Canopy, Suspension etc.)
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product are an integral feature to achieving the specified rating, if replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same grade (8.8) & quality are used. Contact an authorised TAG distributer or the TAG fitment centre - (07) 3208 3022 - if further information is required.

#### **Towbar Maintenance and Care:**

It is recommended, when not in use, the Tow Ball Mount assembly and class 4 Pin and Clip is stored inside the car away from moisture to prevent standing water from forming rust. Inspect to ensure, on regular basis, fasteners are torqued to the specifications below and in good condition.

Ensure that the fitting instructions are read and understood prior to fitment Place these instructions in the vehicle's glovebox after installation is completed

Tools required: Spanners, Sockets, Screwdriver, Torque wrench



#### Step 1. Fit Towbar

- a. Remove the centre aluminium step from the bumper and retain.
- b. Remove 3x M10 from the outside of each chassis rail and discard.
- c. Lift towbar up to the outside of the chassis and secure the bar loosely with 3x M10x 30 bolts with washers.
- d. Secure the centre of the towbar to the underside of the cross member with the remaining 3x M10 bolts with washers.
- e. Tighten all bolts to the torque specification on page 2.
- f. Using holes in chassis base plates as a guide, drill 13mm holes into bottom of chassis. (long drill bit required).
- g. Insert 5x 1/2" bolt with washers from underneath and secure on top of chassis rail with nuts & washers. Tighten to M12 torque specs.
- h. Mark the aluminium step section for cutting.175mm (W) x 40mm (D). Cut using an air saw or similar.
- i. Refit to step section to bumper.
- j. Fit the plastic receiver cover
- k. Insert the ball mount & secure with the pull pin & clip.

### **Step 2. Fit Ball Mount and Apply compliance Label**

a. Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door. Leave the remaining label & the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook...
